News from India



Recently, Asok, a Pebbles and Stones leader from India, spent a week with Kathleen in Michigan. He will be in the States until August raising support. Asok, his wife and two children, live in Cochin. He attended Bible School and is currently a pastor. He has taught in Seminaries, schools, and in church house meetings. He is training pastors and overseeing Pebbles and Stones groups in India. He is also coordinating the translation of the Pebbles and Stones curriculum into Malayalam. Currently, he is working with 1,000 children and 60 leaders. His greatest needs are prayer coverage, funds for the translation of additional P&S materials, a vehicle for the ministry and support for pastors who work under him. For sharing the gospel, he was once dragged from his home, kicked and beaten in the street. Joining with another key pastor in India, Pebbles and Stones will be hosting a training in India in 2011. Please keep our brothers and sisters from India in your prayers and please pray for full provision for the training. Please pray to see how the Lord might lead you to support Pebbles and Stones in India.
