

Of the 68,000,000 million people living in Thailand, ninety-nine percent are Buddhist. Less than 1% of Thailand is Christian. Partnering with One Hope and Children In Prayer, Pebbles and Stones held three trainings in Bangkok. We were also privileged to be with the children from the International Church. On Saturday, October 16th, over twenty-six children's leaders participated in an all day training held in the Bangkok Christian Church. The participants were receptive and participated openly and asked questions about an intergenerational approach. The importance of providing a quiet place for each participant to "hear God's voice," journal and prayer was stressed. One young girl shared about the choice to come out of darkness and into light. Her page launched us into a time of prayer for each other to follow Christ as well as for the country. The teachers were eager to implement what they had learned in their classrooms. On Sunday, October 17th, with the Children's Church of the International Christian Assembly (ICA), forty-seven children participated in a Pebbles and Stones meeting. The journal pages were significant as each one shared his/her page and prayed for families, friends, Thailand, and personal needs. This evening of training ended in an amazing time of pure Holy Spirit lead prayer.
